Know what you are interviewing for.



Designing Macbeth

- Assess the intent of the script and/or director.
- Assess the physical architecture of the playing space.
- Assess the Movement, Tone, and Tempo of the blocking.
- Assess how to define the space.

A Lighting Design Process

Elements & Principles of design are used to communicate a **Vocabulary** with the audience.

A <u>Vocabulary</u> is the means in which we translate lighting ideas based on contextual clues within the script to the audience.


ROOM TC121 SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE LAYOUT




